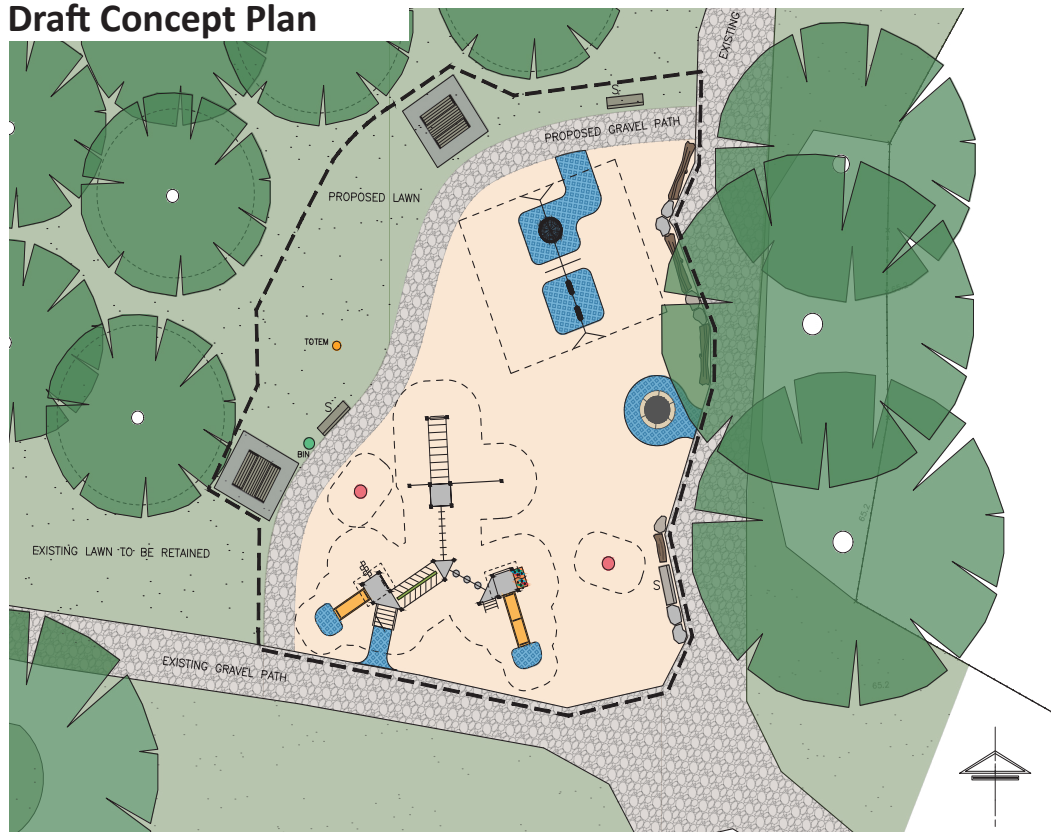


Knox City Council is committed to supporting an active and healthy community
